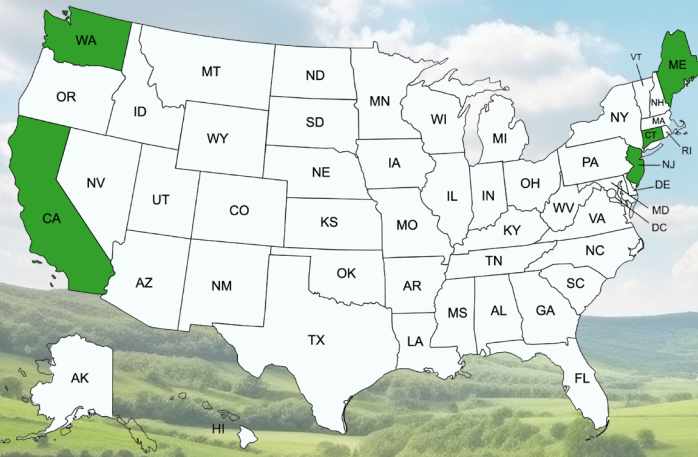


Current Laws & Requirements for PCR by State

As of August 2025, legislation in 5 states mandates post-consumer recycled (PCR) plastic content in packaging.
